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

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. APPLICATION OF TARIFF:

The charges and provisions as contained herein apply only in connection with the transportation of passengers and their baggage in charter party service between points within the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District.

2. SEATING CAPACITY:

The term "seating capacity" as used herein means the total number of seats in the vehicle, exclusive of the driver's seat.

3. CHARTER TRIP OR CHARTER PARTY SERVICE:

The term "charter Trip" or "charter party service" as used herein means the transportation of a group of persons, who pursuant to a common purpose and under a single contract, and at a fixed charge for the vehicle in accordance with this tariff, have acquired the exclusive use of one of the carrier's vehicles to travel together as a group to a specified destination or for a particular itinerary, either agreed upon in advance or modified by the charter group after having left the place of origin. Said charter trip or charter party service begins at time charter group has specified it desires the vehicle to report to the specified origin point and ends with the discharge of such charter group at their specified destination or return point of discharge.

4. BAGGAGE:

Baggage will not be checked. Personal baggage, musical instruments, athletic equipment and other paraphernalia necessary for the purpose of the charter trip and limited to the capacity of the charter vehicle will be transported in custody of the chartering party at no additional charge. Carrier assumes no responsibility or liability for such personal baggage and/or property transported by it.

5. LIABILITY FOR DELAYS:

- (a) Carrier will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, and bad conditions of the highways, snowstorms or any other condition beyond its control.
- (b) If conditions over which this carrier has no control, such as weather, road conditions or Acts of God, make it, in the opinion of this carrier,

unadvisable to operate a charter either from the point of origin or at any point en route, carrier shall not be liable therefore or be caused to be held for damage for any reasons whatsoever.

6. AVAILABILITY OF EQUIPMENT:

All quotations are subject to the carrier being able to supply equipment. The charges shown herein apply only when proper arrangements have been made for the furnishing of equipment and only when this carrier can properly meet with all of the requirements of any city, state, national or state park, monument or reservation through or to which it is the desire of the party chartering the vehicle (s) to pass.

7. PASSENGER LIMIT, PER VEHICLE:

The company reserves the right to limit the number of passengers that it will carry on any vehicle in excess of the seated capacity of the vehicle or to refuse to carry any such excess passengers.

8. OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS:

The carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons under the influence of drugs or intoxicating liquor, or whose conduct is such, or likely to be such, as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers.

9. ANIMALS OR PETS:

Dogs and other animals, birds, etc., excepting properly muzzled "seeing eye" dogs in the service of a blind person, will not be carried on a vehicle in charter service.

10. CANCELLATION POLICY AND CHARGES:

Payment Policy: Unless satisfactory credit arrangements are established, an advance deposit of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) or 10%; whichever is greater, of the total charter price per bus must be made within 14 days of reservation.

Cancellation policy: A forfeiture of deposit will apply to any charter cancelled within 14 days of scheduled departure. Any charter cancelled within 48 hours of departure will be assessed the minimum charge for the service originally requested. Cancellation at point of origin will be charged the full rate of service. Any service cancelled prior to 14 days will receive a refund of all money deposited.

Return Check Policy: a \$25.00 per returned check fee will be charged for all returned checks; furthermore, any legal fees and interest may also be assessed.

11. DAMAGE TO VEHICLE:

In the event a chartered vehicle is damaged by members of the charter party, the cost of proper repair of such damage shall be charged to and promptly paid by the charter party.

12. SPECIAL CHARGES, TOLLS, AND TAXES:

- (a) The cost of all bridge, ferry, tunnel, and highway tolls together with all parking charges shall be included as separate and additional charges in the determination of rates.
- (b) The cost of any Federal Tax on transportation of persons, all special license fees, permits, taxes and other charges that may be imposed on chartered bus operations by the Federal Government, and state, count, parish, or municipality, shall be included as a separate and additional charge in the determination of rates.

2. COMPUTATION OF CHARGES AND DESIGNATION OF EQUIPMENT POINT:

Hours in chartered vehicle service will be computed as beginning at the time the vehicle is ordered to report, or the actual time the vehicle reports, to the time the vehicle returns to the origin point or arrives at the agreed destination, plus a charge of one (1) hour to cover carrier's operations from and to its designated equipment point at Fredericksburg, VA.

3. DISCOUNTS:

A discount of ten percent from carrier's charges shown above for charter service might be allowed for travel agents and tour brokers.

4. DRIVER'S EXPENSESE:

A charge for one-day trips of \$10.00 will be applied on all charter movements in excess of (10) ten hours. A charge of \$50.00 will be added to all charges that include an overnight stay and the customer is paying for the driver's accommodations.
