**Georgetown University Transportation Shuttle
(GUTS)**

Regularly scheduled irregular route service is available to transport all Georgetown University faculty, staff, full-time students, MedStar Georgetown University Hospital ("MGUH") employees, independent contractors who perform clinical functions at MGUH, and any other Georgetown University approved contractors or staff of MGUH, and Georgetown University and MGUH patrons (visitors to the Main Campus, University program attendees, and MGUH patient care facilities and offices) as passengers between Georgetown University's campus GUTS Bus Stops and scheduled irregular route drop-off and pick-up points, including all scheduled intermediate stops. Irregular route service also includes GUTS charter service.

I. Practices, Rules, and Regulations

1. Service on all routes is available to all Georgetown University faculty, staff, and students and MGUH employees, contractors or staff who display a valid Georgetown University or MGUH identification card. Service is also available to non-Georgetown University patrons who are visitors to the Main Campus, attending programs conducted on the University, are receiving care as an outpatient or are a visitor of a patient at the MGUH, or associated groups using the GUTS charter service.
2. All University faculty, staff, and students must display a valid personal Georgetown University Identification card when boarding any GUTS bus. All MGUH employees, contractors, or staff must present a valid MGUH identification card when boarding any GUTS bus.
3. All non-Georgetown University or non-MGUH riders must present a valid ID card when boarding bus and sign a sheet indicating where they are going on campus. Groups using the GUTS charter service will already have been cleared as a group for entry onto the bus.
4. Smoking, eating, and drinking are not permitted on any GUTS bus. Violation of this rule is cause for the individual violator to be removed from the bus without recourse towards GUTS. In addition, any behavior found to be unruly, disruptive, or jeopardizing the safe operation of a GUTS bus is cause for the removal of the individual(s) at the discretion of the driver.
5. GUTS normally operates from 5:00AM until 12:00AM Monday through Friday. Dates and operating times may be changed at the discretion of the Georgetown University Office of Transportation Management due to weather conditions, University work schedules, or other liketype occurrences which impact the schedule of operations for GUTS service.

26 Passenger Bus	Over One (1) Hour	\$80.00/hour (4 hour minimum)
34 Passenger Bus	Over One (1) Hour	\$85.00 hour (4 four minimum)
40 Passenger Bus	Over One (1) Hour	\$90.00/hour (4 hour minimum)


