**SECTION I
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. **APPLICATION OF TARIFF:**

The charges and provision named herein apply in connection with the transportation of passengers and their baggage in buses chartered for the exclusive use of parties between points within the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District.

2. **TOLL, PARKING AND OTHER SIMILAR CHARGES:**

The charges named herein do not include bridge, tunnel, ferry fees, highway toll charges, or parking charges; such additional charges must be paid by the party chartering the vehicle.

3. **HAND BAGGAGE AND OTHER PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT**

Hand baggage and other property and equipment will be accepted for transportation only to the capacity of the vehicle. Baggage will not be checked. This includes personal baggage, musical instruments, athletic equipment and other paraphernalia necessary for the chartered trip. Subject equipment will be transported in the custody of the chartering party at no additional charge.

4. **DEADHEAD MILEAGE:**

Deadhead mileage means the mileage traversed in moving a vehicle from the closest equipment point to the originating point of the chartered trip and return to the original equipment point. Equipment availability points for the charter service will be: Alexandria, Annandale, Springfield in Virginia, and Rockville and Brentwood in Maryland.

5. **REPORT CHARGE:**

A dispatch charge of a minimum of \$ 195.00 will be made for each vehicle, when the vehicle is ordered to report for service and service is cancelled after the bus has been dispatched.

6 **LIABILITY FOR DELAYS:**

The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, bad road conditions, snow storms or other conditions which may cause delays beyond its control.

7. **DEPOSITS:**

Unless satisfactory credit has been established, a deposit equal to the base amount of the charter must be received with each order. Such deposits must be received not later than 14 working days prior to the start of the charter trip. Written, faxed, or oral cancellation must be received at least one hundred sixty eight hours prior to the start of the charter.

8. **FEDERAL OR OTHER TRANSPORTATION TAX:**

Federal or other transportation tax in effect at the time the chartered bus service is rendered shall be added to fares and charges stated herein.

9. **CHANGES EN ROUTE:**

If changes en route from the original movement are ordered by the party chartering the vehicle, any additional mileage resulting therefrom will be computed upon the charges set forth herein.

10 **OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS:**

The carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons under the influence of drugs or intoxicating liquor, or whose conduct is such, or likely to be such, as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers.

11. **DAMAGE TO VEHICLE:**

The chartering party will be held liable for all interior and exterior damage caused directly by the participants of the chartering party.

SCHEDULE OF CHARGES**

- A. On all one-way or round-trip movements, the charges will be assessed by hours.

The following charges will apply, subject to other rules and regulations contained herein:

\$ 195.00 for the first four hours of school bus type vehicle usage with a four hour minimum charge

\$ 45.00 per hour or any part hour after the first four hours
