CHARTER**

1. APPLICATION OF TARIFF

The rates, charges, rules and regulations contained herein apply to:

The transportation of passengers in special or charter parties between the geographic areas composed of the Cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, and Virginia.

And the Counties of Prince Georges County and Montgomery County Maryland and the District of Columbia. Also including transportation of passengers between points in Prince Georges County, Montgomery County, Maryland and the District of Columbia as well as between points within the District of Columbia, Prince Georges County and Montgomery County, Maryland.

2. RATES AND CHARGES

Carrier will charge the following rates for the following vehicle types

WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE MINI VAN (5 PASSENGER)	3 HOUR MINIMUM	\$120.00	EACH ADD'L. HOUR	\$40.00
WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE MODIFIED VAN (8 PASSENGER)	3 HOUR MINIMUM	\$135.00	EACH ADD'L. HOUR	\$45.00
WHEELCHAIR ACCESS SMALL BUS (10 PASSENGER)	3 HOUR MINIMUM	\$135.00	EACH ADD'L. HOUR	\$45.00
STANDARD PASSENGER VAN (14 PASSENGERS)	3 HOUR MINIMUM	\$120.00	EACH ADD'L. HOUR	\$40.00
WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE MINIBUS (20 PASSENGERS)	3 HOUR MINIMUM	\$150.00	EACH ADD'L. HOUR	\$50.00

NOTE: DEADHEAD TIME FROM AND TO CARRIER'S ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA EQUIPMENT POINT WILL BE CHARGED AT THE HOURLY RATE FOR EACH HOUR OR PORTION THEREOF.

3. ADDITIONAL CHARGES

- A. **WAITING TIME:** There is no charge for the first 15 minutes. Afterwards, waiting time is charged at the rate of \$40.00 in quarterly increments of \$10.
- B. **PARKING, TOLLS AND SPECIAL CHARGES:** The charges herein do not include bridge, ferry, tunnel or highway tolls, entrance fees or charges for special licenses or permits. An additional fee will be assessed to cover carrier's cost for such charges.
- C. **CANCELLATION CHARGE:** Cancellations made within less than 24 hours of schedules charter are subject to cancellation charge calculated as the minimum 3 hour charter rate.

- D. **CLEANING CHARGE:** If in Carrier's reasonable opinion, any passenger or passengers so foul(s) the vehicle as to render in a particularly dirty condition, a cleaning charge of \$75 will be assessed.
- E. **DAMAGE CHARGE:** Carrier inspects Vehicles prior to pick-up. Any damage to seats, windows or other equipment or parts of the vehicle which is caused by a passenger shall be the responsibility of such passenger and Carrier's cost of repair shall be paid by that passenger.

4. **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- A. Carrier does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time and will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, traffic conditions, inclement weather, strikes, Acts of God or other conditions beyond its control.
- B. Baggage will not be checked and is limited to the capacity of the vehicle. Carrier assumes no liability for baggage and for personal property transported by it.
- C. Carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons appearing under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs or whose conduct is such, or is likely to be such, as to make him/her objectionable to other passengers or threaten the safe operation of the vehicle

5. **APPLICATION OF TARIFF**

The rates, charges, rules and regulations contained herein apply to:

The transportation of passengers over irregular routes on an irregular schedule between the geographic areas composed of the Cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Virginia.

And the Counties of Prince Georges County and Montgomery County Maryland and the District of Columbia. Also including transportation of passengers between points in Prince Georges County, Montgomery County, Maryland and the District of Columbia as well as between points within the District of Columbia, Prince Georges County and Montgomery County, Maryland.

6. **RATES AND CHARGES**

Carrier will charge the following rates for one-way transportation between the following points:

- A. **Between Alexandria City and all other points in the District of Columbia and Maryland.**
\$20.00 pick-up fee and the rate of \$2 per mile from the pick-up point to the destinations outside of Alexandria and within Prince Georges County, Montgomery County and the District of Columbia.
- B. **Between Arlington County and all other points in the District of Columbia and Maryland.**
\$20.00 pick-up fee and the rate of \$2 per mile from the pick-up point to the destinations outside of Alexandria and within Prince Georges County, Montgomery County and the District of Columbia.
- C. **Between Falls Church City and all other points in the District of Columbia and Maryland.**
\$20.00 pick-up fee and the rate of \$2 per mile from the pick-up point to the destinations outside of Alexandria and within Prince Georges County, Montgomery County and the District of Columbia.

D. Between Fairfax City and all other points in the District of Columbia and Maryland.

\$25.00 pick-up fee and the rate of \$2 per mile from the pick-up point to the destinations outside of Alexandria and within Prince Georges County, Montgomery County and the District of Columbia.

E. Between Fairfax County and all other points in the District of Columbia and Maryland.

\$25.00 pick-up fee and the rate of \$2 per mile from the pick-up point to the destinations outside of Alexandria and within Prince Georges County, Montgomery County and the District of Columbia.

NOTE: A PASSENGER IS PERMITTED TO TRAVEL WITH ONE (1) COMPANION AT NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE. EACH ADDITIONAL PASSENGER OF A PRE-FORMED GROUP SHARING A COMMON ORIGIN AND DESTINATION SHALL BE CHARGED A FLATE RATE OF \$5.00

7. ADDITIONAL CHARGES

A. WAITING TIME: There is no charge for the first 15 minutes. Afterwards, waiting time is charged at the rate of \$40.00 in quarterly increments of \$10.

B. PARKING, TOLLS AND SPECIAL CHARGES: The charges herein do not include bridge, ferry, tunnel or highway tolls, entrance fees or charges for special licenses or permits. An additional fee will be assessed to cover carrier's cost for such charges.

C. CANCELLATION CHARGE: Cancellations made within less than 4 hours of schedules pick-up are subject to a cancellation charge calculated as the minimum charge of one-way service.

D. CLEANING CHARGE: If in Carrier's reasonable opinion, any passenger or passengers so foul(s) the vehicle as to render in a particularly dirty condition, a cleaning charge of \$75 will be assessed.

E. DAMAGE CHARGE: Carrier inspects Vehicles prior to pick-up. Any damage to seats, windows or other equipment or parts of the vehicle, which is caused by a passenger, shall be the responsibility of such passenger and that passenger shall pay Carrier's cost of repair.

8. RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Mileage based rates are calculated via the shortest timed route using MapQuest computer software. Although fares are calculated via the shortest timed route, Carrier does not endeavor to follow such routes or routes. Carrier reserves the right to select the route and highways to be used in all transportation services.

B. Carrier does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time and will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, traffic conditions, inclement weather, strikes, Acts of God or other conditions beyond its control.

C. Baggage will not be checked and is limited to the capacity of the vehicle. Carrier assumes no liability for baggage and for personal property transported by it.

D. Carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons appearing under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs or whose conduct is such, or is likely to be such, as to make him/her objectionable to other passengers or threaten the safe operation of the vehicle
