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Old Town Trolley Tours Fares and Rates

OVERVIEW

Application of the Tariff

The fares stated herein are applicable to the transportation of passengers on the trolley tour systems of Old Town Trolley Tours of Washington, Inc. both from one point to another, and also for a fixed route, circular, Hop on, Hop off style tour which includes live narration and encompasses the historic districts and National Mall region of Washington DC.

Fare and Service Policies

Old Town Trolley Tours' fare and service policies are designed to ensure that there is no discrimination based on race, color, national origin, or other demographic factors. Our fare structure is intended to distribute the effects of any service or pricing changes equitably across all populations.

The General Manager, under the policy direction of company ownership, is authorized to implement rules and regulations to ensure the safe, convenient, and orderly operation of Old Town Trolley Tours. This includes setting and enforcing policies related to fare collection, the protection of company facilities, and the safety and well-being of the riding public.

Schedule Changes

Old Town Trolley Tours reserves the right to change schedules of the tour service without advance notice to the public, except as required by WMATC regulations.

Emergency Fare Reduction

The General Manager, or his designee, is authorized to reduce any otherwise applicable fare or fee when faced with emergency conditions, service interruptions or when sections of the primary route may be inaccessible due to a public demonstration, protest or street closures which are outside of the operator's control.

The General Manager or his designee, is authorized to reduce applicable fare or fee under the following conditions:

- If 10% or less of the service is impacted due to emergency conditions or interruptions, the fare or fee shall be reduced by \$5.
- If more than 10% but not more than 20% of the service is impacted, the fare or fee shall be reduced by \$10.
- If more than 20% of the service is impacted, the fare or fee shall be reduced by \$15.

The General Manager will notify company ownership of any such decision as soon as practicable after the event. No other agent or employee shall have the authority to change or deviate from the fare or charges contained herein.

TROLLEY TOUR SERVICES

Day Tour Fares

Old Town Trolley Tours offers comprehensive day tour services with a value-based pricing structure based on the time of ticket purchase. This provides optimal accessibility throughout the year with a very clear pricing schedule for all guests wishing to purchase tickets.

Night Tour Fares

Night Tours, branded as 'Monuments by Moonlight', are an important part of the visitor experience. All Night Tour bookings require advance purchase and are subject to seasonal and advance purchase pricing as outlined in the fare table.

Seasonal Pricing

Old Town Trolley Tours operates under a flexible, value-based pricing structure designed to provide optimal value for all guests and assist with being able to manage capacity throughout the year:

- **Peak Season (March 10 - July 31):** Higher demand period with premium pricing
- **Off Season (August 1 – September 30 & November 1 – March 9):** Reduced pricing to encourage ridership during lower demand periods
- **Shoulder Season (October 1 - October 31):** Moderate pricing during transitional period

Closures/Delayed Starts/Early Closing for Special Events

Old Town Trolley Tours does not operate on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day or Independence Day. On other days, due to events and activities, Old Town Trolley Tours may open late, may close early, or occasionally not operate at all if roads are closed, and access is restricted. If there are road closures and service restrictions, and days when the streets are not accessible due to special events, service information will be posted on the www.trolleytours.com and the www.trustedtours.com websites.

SALES OF TOUR PRODUCTS

Retail Outlets

Tour tickets may be purchased at authorized retail outlets including, but not limited to, The Washington DC Welcome Center at 1001 E St NW, Washington DC, 20004, any Old Town Trolley Tours sales kiosk or booth located within Washington DC, Hotel or Third-Party Travel & Tour Sales Desks and independently authorized Sales Agents or Representatives.

Potential customers wishing to purchase a ticket may do so via Apple Pay, Google Wallet, in person with cash or credit/debit cards.

Online Sales

Online ticket purchases are available directly from Old Town Trolley Tours through www.trolleytours.com and www.trustedtours.com

In addition to these websites, online tickets are available through numerous authorized third-party vendors including Online Travel Agents, other Attraction Providers, and independent third-party sales agents.

Advance Purchase of Tickets

Tour tickets may be purchased in advance by using one of the online sales channels or at one of our retail outlets.

When a customer buys tickets in advance, the customer can benefit from the advance purchase fare shown in the fare table.

If the customer chooses to purchase in advance, the price is clearly indicated on the Old Town Trolley Tours websites so that customers are able to make an educated decision about their time of purchase.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

100% Satisfaction Guarantee

If after taking the tour, a guest is dissatisfied with the tour, the guest can request a refund of the full purchase price that they paid for their tickets.

Date or Time Specific Tickets

Due to limited seating availability, date and/or time specific tickets are non-refundable if they are not used on the reservation date (no show). Guests may reschedule their date/time up to twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the tour/trip time under the "Rescheduling" terms detailed on the Old Town Trolley Tours website.

Rescheduling Tours

For guests that have purchased tickets directly from an Old Town Trolley Tours website, they may take advantage of the Old Town Trolley Tours "Modify Booking Tool" located at www.trolleytours.com/manage. At this website customers may change their reservation one-time at no charge*.

Each customer is fully responsible if the fare price for the new date/time selected is more expensive than the original booking.

*Additional Changes – If the customer made changes previously and needs to make additional modifications to their tour or attraction date/time, they must then contact the operator by phone to confirm availability.

If the customer purchased their tour or attraction product at a local sales kiosk or booth, then they must contact the local operation directly to make any itinerary changes. If the customer purchased the tour or attraction product from a third-party online travel agency (Viator, Expedia, Get Your Guide, Trip Advisor etc.) they must contact those parties directly to make any changes.

Weather and Force Majeure:

If Old Town Trolley Tours of Historic Tours of America cancels a tour/trip due to inclement weather, equipment breakdown, civil order, or other force majeure event, guests are offered a choice of a refund or rescheduling to a future date.

Ridership Rules and Guidelines

OVERVIEW

Jurisdictional Laws

Old Town Trolley Tours of Washington, Inc. shall follow and observe all criminal laws, codes and standards of public decency. This includes all laws relating to lewd, obscene, threatening or disruptive behavior within the multi-jurisdictional transit region of Virginia, Maryland, and Washington DC.

RIDERSHIP RULES

Ticketed Passengers

All passengers wishing to board an Old Town Trolley Tours or Historic Tours of America sightseeing tour vehicle must have in their possession a valid ticket. This ticket must clearly show the date, name of the tour that the ticket is valid for, the time of departure, (if applicable), and the number of passengers that the ticket is valid for.

Old Town Trolley Tours reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone not in possession of a valid ticket.

Embarking and Disembarking

Passengers may only embark and board an Old Town Trolley Tours vehicle when permitted to do so by the authorized driver of the vehicle, or his/her designated representative.

Except in the event of an emergency, disembarking is only permitted at designated 'trolley stops' which are authorized by the relevant authorities. Each of these locations must also be approved and authorized by the local operation's Safety Officer, Operations Manager and General Manager.

Capacity Limitations

Old Town Trolley Tours reserves the right to refuse entry to a vehicle if permitting entry would cause the vehicle to operate with more passengers than the approved seating capacity of the vehicle.

SERVICE CHANGE OR INTERRUPTION

Schedule Changes

Old Town Trolley Tours reserves the right to change tour service schedules without notice to the public, except as required by WMATC regulations.

Service Delays

Occasionally, due to events and activities, Old Town Trolley Tours may open late, may close early, or occasionally not operate at all if roads are closed, and access is restricted. During such times, Old Town Trolley Tours shall not hold any liability for failure to provide service.

Accidents and Delays

Old Town Trolley Tours will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, road or traffic conditions, severe weather, or other conditions beyond its control and provides no guarantee that passengers will arrive at or depart from any point at any specific time. Old Town Trolley Tours shall not be liable for a failure to provide service either from the point of origin or to any point enroute due to conditions over which Old Town Trolley Tours has no control. This may

include, but is not limited to, Acts of God, acts of terrorism or other violence, or road conditions that make it inadvisable and/or dangerous to operate service in the sole opinion of Old Town Trolley Tours. In such instances, Old Town Trolley Tours shall not be liable for damage for any reason whatsoever.

PASSENGER CONDUCT

Unacceptable and Prohibited Conduct

Old Town Trolley Tours strives to provide a safe, comfortable environment on all its vehicles, where passengers can enjoy a sightseeing tour with an interesting and educational narration. Unacceptable conduct is any conduct that a reasonable person believes is disturbing the peace or enjoyment of other Old Town Trolley Tours' passengers or interrupting the narrative experience of the sightseeing tour. To this end, Old Town Trolley Tours reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons exhibiting unacceptable or prohibited conduct.

The following conduct is prohibited on all Old Town Trolley Tours vehicles and property:

1. Failure to pay an established fare.
2. To vend, sell or attempt to sell any item, thing or device.
3. Expectoration (spitting) in or upon any part of any Old Town Trolley Tours employee or vehicle.
4. Smoking or carrying a lighted or smoldering pipe, cigar, or cigarette, or vaping, including the use of any type of 'e' cigarette or nicotine dispensing device, within any Old Town Trolley Tour property or vehicle.
5. The consumption of alcohol within any Old Town Trolley Tour property or vehicle, unless it has been specifically authorized during certain tour programs.

6. The use of drugs of any kind that have not been prescribed for use by a registered medical professional and are required to be taken as a medical necessity.
7. Standing in front of the yellow line marked on the forward end of the floor of any vehicle or otherwise conducting oneself in such a manner as to obstruct the vision of the operator.
8. Any conduct which interferes with the safe operation of the vehicle.
9. Unauthorized boarding any Old Town Trolley Tours vehicle without express permission being granted by the operator or other designated Old Town Trolley Tours employee.
10. Discarding litter or trash in or upon any Old Town Trolley Tours property or vehicle.
11. Playing any device or instrument that is audible to other passengers and disturbs the narrative experience of a sightseeing tour.
12. Displaying signs or clothing that communicate a harmful or offensive personal or political position and/or message.
13. Abusive behavior of any kind.

Abusive Behavior

Abusive behavior is any action that physically or verbally attacks, harms, endangers or injures any person, including oneself, or causes willful damage to the property of Old Town Trolley Tours or property of another passenger or employee/operator. Any person exhibiting abusive behavior will be asked to leave Old Town Trolley Tours property or vehicle, and subsequent legal action may be taken.

Right to Refuse Service

Old Town Trolley Tours reserves the right to refuse service and access to property/vehicles belonging to Old Town Trolley Tours, to anyone exhibiting or believed to be exhibiting unacceptable or prohibited conduct.

PASSENGER CARRY-ONS

Ordinary Items

Passengers may carry ordinary items such as hand baggage and instrument cases, tool cases, folding baby carriages, strollers, wheelchairs, or other small packages and objects that can be handled without inconvenience to other passengers. Carry-on items and objects shall not interfere with entrance or exit, free use of the aisle, or the proper and safe operation of the vehicle. Passengers must always remain with their possessions. Unattended items and objects may be confiscated and/or destroyed for safety and security reasons.

Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards and any type of Automatic Balancing Wheeled Conveyance.

Old Town Trolley is unable to accommodate any type of bicycle, scooter, skateboard or automatic balancing wheeled conveyance. Any passenger in possession of such an item will be required to make alternate arrangements for the secure storage of such an item prior to embarking on their sightseeing tour.

Carriage of Animals

Animals and pets, (See Service Animals for Exceptions), of any kind are prohibited from Old Town Trolley Tours property and vehicles.

Prohibited Carry-Ons

Passengers are prohibited from bringing any flammable or combustible liquids, explosives, acids, or any other inherently dangerous item onto Old Town Trolley Tours property or vehicles.

BAGGAGE

Customers Responsibilities

Passengers with ordinary items accept that their baggage will not be checked, and no provision for baggage will be made. Any baggage brought onboard an Old Town Trolley Tours vehicle, or brought onto Old Town Trolley Tours property, is the responsibility of the guests and/or respective baggage owner(s).

SERVICE ANIMALS AND DISABLED PASSENGERS

Service Animals

Trained service animals used by persons with disabilities are permitted on all Old Town Trolley Tours property and vehicles. Service animals include but are not limited to dogs and miniature horses that have been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for persons with disabilities.

Exotic animals are not considered service animals under the ADA.

Comfort or therapy animals, which are used solely to provide emotional support, are also not considered service animals under the ADA. Pets, exotic animals or emotional support animals are not permitted on Old Town Trolley Tours property or vehicles.

In circumstances where it may not be obvious that a particular animal is a trained service animal, Old Town Trolley Tours staff may ask the individual with the animal if it is a service animal and subsequently ask what service the animal provides. Old Town Trolley Tours will not request written assurances before permitting the service animal to accompany the person with the disability. Service animals are not allowed to ride on the seats in Old Town Trolley Tours vehicles.

Priority Seating

On Old Town Trolley Tours vehicles which are equipped with a wheelchair or mobility device lift have several rows of seats of the vehicle that are designed to be folded up to accommodate these devices. If, during the course of regular service, a passenger who requires the use of a wheelchair or mobility device wishes to board the vehicle, passengers sitting in these seats may be asked to relocate to other seats within the vehicle.

Mobility Devices, including wheelchairs, scooters and other mobile devices.

Some Old Town Trolley Tours vehicles are equipped with hydraulic wheelchair lifts designed to allow an individual who are unable to board the vehicle unassisted to be lifted from ground level into the passenger compartment of the vehicle.

Passengers are not required to book an accessible vehicle in advance; however, prior notice is encouraged as this reduces any potential wait time and ensures that a vehicle will be available at the requested time for boarding.

The lift will be operated by a trained vehicle and wheelchair lift operator, or their designated trained representative, to ensure that the guest is safe and securely accommodated.

Passengers using mobility scooters that are not designed or not manufactured for use while a vehicle is in motion are required to transfer to a trolley seat.

SMOKING

On Vehicles

Smoking or carrying a lighted or smoldering pipe, cigar, or cigarette, or vaping, including the use of any type of 'e' cigarette or nicotine dispensing device, is prohibited onboard any Old Town Trolley Tour vehicle.

At Stops/Stands/Ticketing Locations

Except in designated areas, smoking or carrying a lighted or smoldering pipe, cigar, or cigarette, or vaping, including the use of any type of 'e' cigarette or nicotine dispensing device, is prohibited.

LOST AND FOUND

Lost Item Reporting

Lost items should be reported immediately to Old Town Trolley Tours. Once the report has been submitted, Old Town Trolley Tours will make reasonable efforts to locate lost items but assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen personal property. All claims for lost or damaged personal items must be received in writing within thirty (30) days of the loss to the office of the company at 5400 Tuxedo Road, Hyattsville, MD 20871.
