RULES AND REGULATIONS

5 APPLICATION OF TARIFF:

The rules, regulations, fares and charges, as set forth herein, apply in connection with the provisions of all charter services authorized to be provided by Jewish Council for the Aging of Greater Washington, Inc., pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 159, issued in Case No. MP-91-02, pursuant to WMATC Order No. 3696.

10 CHARGES FOR CHARTER SERVICE:

The charge for charter services shall be as follows:

- A. The charge for charter service shall be \$20.00 per hour or portion thereof for wheelchair equipped vehicles with a seating capacity of not more than 15 persons.
 - B. The charge for charter service in vans with a seating capacity of not more than 30 persons shall be \$20.00 per hour of portion thereof.
 - C. The charge for charter service in mini-coaches with a seating capacity not to exceed 30 passengers shall be \$20.00 per hour or portion thereof.
 - D. For all charter service, a two (2) hour minimum shall apply. Time shall be calculated from the time the charter vehicle leaves the garage to begin the charter trip until the time the vehicle returns to the garage at the conclusion of the charter trip.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

15 CHARGES FOR SPECIAL OPERATIONS SERVICE:

The charge for special operations service shall be as follows:

I. Lunch Program Transportation

- A. Transportation between points in Washington, D.C. and Montgomery and Prince George's County, Maryland, restricted to transportation to or from an established senior citizen lunch program.

Charge per one-way trip - \$.50 - under 2 miles
\$.75 - over 2 miles

(Any passenger not paying the established charge will be carried for free.)

II. Adult Day Care Transportation

- A. Transportation between points in Washington, D.C. and Montgomery County, Maryland, on the one hand, and on the other, the facilities of the Jewish Council for the Aging in Rockville, Maryland.

Charge - \$ 6.00 per round trip

(Transportation charges to be paid monthly.)

III. Shopping Service

- A. The charge for transportation between residences and shopping facilities performed wholly within the District of Columbia shall be \$.50 per one-way trip.
- B. The charge for transportation between residences in the district of Columbia and shopping facilities in Montgomery County, Maryland shall be \$.75 per one-way trip.
- C. The charge for transportation between residences in Montgomery County, Maryland and shopping facilities in Montgomery County shall be \$.50 per one-way trip.

15 CHARGES FOR SPECIAL OPERATIONS SERVICE:

- D. The charge for transportation between residences in Virginia and shopping facilities in Montgomery County, Maryland shall be \$.75 per one-way trip.

(Any passenger not paying the established charge will be carried for free.)

IV. Transportation to medical appointments.

- A. The charge for transportation between points in Montgomery County, Maryland and the District of Columbia, restricted to transportation to or from medical appointments, shall be \$ 5.00 per one-way trip.
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
