

SECTION I
RULES AND REGULATIONS

5 APPLICATION OF TARIFF:

The Rules, Regulations, fares and charges, as set forth herein, apply in connection with the provision of all services authorized to be provided by Peter Pan Bus Lines, Inc., pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 232, issued in Case No. AP-93-19, pursuant to WMATC Order No. 4149.

10 AVAILABILITY OF EQUIPMENT:

Charges named herein are based on vehicles being furnished of sufficient seating capacity to accommodate the chartering party; but carrier reserves the right, when operating conditions so require, to furnish vehicles of greater capacity, charges to be based on the capacity of vehicle ordered.

15 OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS:

Carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or who shows conduct which is such, or is likely to be such, as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers. EXCEPTION: These rules do not apply to persons who are ill and are accompanied by an attendant or nurse.

20 BAGGAGE:

Baggage will not be checked.

(a) For charter trips, personal baggage, musical instruments, athletic equipment and other paraphernalia necessary for the purpose of the charter trip and limited to the capacity of the charter vehicle will be transported in the custody of the chartering party at no additional charge.

SECTION II
 RULE CHARGES FOR CHARTER BUS SERVICE

100 TABLE OF CHARGES:

The following charges will be assessed for each vehicle chartered, per hour or portion thereof, subject to the minimum charges as provided in Rule 105 shown below and other rules and regulations contained herein.

April 1 thru October 31

NOTES: Time is to be calculated from the time the bus leaves the carrier's garage at the beginning of the charter trip until it returns to the carrier's garage at the conclusion of the charter trip.

(C) "Column 1" applies to charter service on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and/or Saturday, except for holidays.

(C) "Column 2" applies to charter service on Friday, Sunday, and/or holidays.

Column 2 rates will apply during the period September 15-October 15.

On the first two weekends in December, apply the April 1 thru October 31 Column 2 rates.

SECTION II
RULE CHARGES FOR CHARTER BUS SERVICE

105 MINIMUM CHARGES:

Charges in Rule 100 shall be subject to the minimum charges in this Rule. A minimum daily charge per charter coach will be assessed as follows:

For charter trips in excess of four hours, the hourly rate in Rule 100 shall apply.

110 AIRPORT TRANSFERS:

This Rule is cancelled.

For applicable rates, see Rules 100 and 110.

SECTION III
RULE CHARGES FOR "PIRATE SHIP" SERVICE

175 MINIMUM NUMBER OF PASSENGERS

Carrier reserves the right, at its sole discretion, not to operate any scheduled trip or trips if there are less than 8 passengers for any particular departure ready at the departure site 10 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time. In the event of cancellation by reason of insufficient ridership, carrier will, at the passenger's option, honor tickets for another tour departure (subject to space availability) or refund the ticket price.

180 PROMOTIONAL FARES

Through and including September 2, 1998, in order to to promote its new service, the carrier will reduce the fares named in this tariff, by use of the following promotions:

- (a) The carrier shall distribute promotional coupons to the public which shall be valid weekdays through and including September 2, 1998. Such promotional coupons shall be honored on a space available basis at departure, on a first come, first served basis. Such coupons shall permit one passenger to travel free with the purchase by another passenger of one full fare ticket of an equal or greater value.

 - (b) The carrier shall sell one discounted "Pirate Ship" ticket to any passenger purchasing a ticket whose value is at least \$29.95 on the carrier's scheduled, intercity bus service. Each qualifying intercity bus passenger may purchase one "Pirate Ship" adult fare ticket for \$12.95 or one child's fare ticket for \$7.95.

185 SIGHTSEEING CHARGES

Subject to the rules in this Tariff, the adult per person fare for the land/water sightseeing trip shall be \$19.95 per adult and \$9.95 per child (See Rule 170)

SECTION III
RULE CHARGES FOR "PIRATE SHIP" SERVICE

190 WEATHER CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to the unique vehicle/vessel "Pirate Ship" operated by carrier, and the land/water nature of the tour, carrier will make every effort to assess at the time of each tour departure weather conditions which would prohibit the operation of the water portion of any scheduled tour. If, in the sole discretion of carrier, it appears that the water portion of the tour will not operate, the carrier's driver/captain will announce this prior to departure. At that time, passengers may choose to seek a refund or to reschedule their reservation for a later departure, on a space available basis.

PIRATE SHIP CHARTER SERVICE

Rules 200 - 205 apply to charter service, involving charter transportation in a unique "Pirate Ship" vehicle/vessel, including a trip of approximately 2 hours, including transportation on land and on the Potomac River.

200 TERRITORY SERVED

Due to the unique nature of the "Pirate Ship" vehicle/vessel, its use is limited to those areas in which it complies with applicable highway use and safety laws. For that reason, the chartering party must identify the precise route of any charter trip at the time of making the reservation. Carrier reserves the right not to operate in any area in which the Pirate Ship, in carrier's sole opinion, may not be operated safely or in accordance with applicable highway laws.

205 CHARGES FOR PIRATE SHIP CHARTER SERVICE

The charge for a two hour charter trip, including both land and water transportation (maximum of 27 passengers) shall be \$450.00. For organized school groups or other organized youth organizations, consisting of children under 13 years old with chaperones, the charge shall be \$250.00.
