Statement of Rules and Practices

Veolia Transportation Services, Inc. ("VTS") provides a variety of transportation services and options throughout the United States. These services include long-term bus and van services, as well as paratransit services, all arranged by contract with both public and private entities. VTS also provides charter bus services for all occasions.

VTS is dedicated to providing high quality, efficient transit options at a competitive price that can be tailored to the individual client's needs. Because of the wide variety of services and needs of our clients, no one set of rules or regulations can apply to all situations, however, VTS assures all of its clients of the use of modern equipment, that is clean, safe and adequately insured. All operators are company employees that are paid competitive wages for the area. All of our drivers receive extensive training prior to transporting any passengers, and each driver's safety and on-time records are closely monitored. Rates for transportation vary from contract to contract, and are also dependent upon size of vehicle and distance traveled. Standard rates are set forth in our motorcoach charter rates for the mid-Atlantic area. Contract transportation rates are generally negotiated well below the charter rates set out here.
