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

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**I. APPLICATION OF TARIFF**

The rates, charges, rules and regulations contained herein apply to:

The transportation of passengers in special or charter parties, between Points of origin in the Cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Counties of Arlington, Fairfax, Dulles International Airport and other points in Washington DC. And the Counties of Montgomery and Prince Georges.

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**II. RATES AND CHARGES**

Carrier will assess the hourly rate:

A. Hourly Rate

- i.) 29 passenger \$95.00 per hour with a minimum of 4 hour charge
- ii.) All reservations must have credit card authorization
- iii.) . We provide smoking and non-smoking vehicles
- iv.) .

NOTE: The hourly rates commence between the pick-up point and end with the drop-off point upon the request of the chartering party.

B. Other Charges

- i.) ~~AB: [REDACTED] with a minimum of 4 hours.~~
- ii.) cleaning charge: If, in Carrier's reasonable opinion, any passenger or passengers so foul(s) the vehicle as to render it in particularly dirty condition, a cleaning charge of \$150.00 will be assessed against the chartering party.
- iii.) damage charge: Buses are carefully inspected by the carrier prior to each charter trip. Any damage to seats, windows, or other equipment or parts of the bus which is caused by any member of the chartering party shall be the responsibility of the chartering

party, and the costs to Carrier for the repairs of such damages shall be paid by the chartering party.

- iv.) tolls, fees, and special charges: The charges herein do not include bridge, ferry, tunnel, or highway tolls, entrance fees or charges for special licenses or permits. An additional charge will be for the cost of such tolls, fees or special charges.

C. Special Transfer Rate

- i.) Rates for bus transfer between Dulles Airport and Washington DC is \$350.00  
Between Ragan National and Washington DC is \$295.00

### III. RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Availability of Equipment:

Charges named herein are based on vehicles being furnished of sufficient seating capacity to accommodate the chartering party; but Carrier reserves the right, when operating conditions so require, to furnish vehicles of greater capacity, charges to be based on the capacity of vehicle ordered.

B. Baggage:

Baggage will not be checked:

- (a) For charter trips, personal baggage, musical instruments, athletic equipment and other paraphernalia necessary for the purpose of the charter trip and limited to the capacity of the charter vehicle will be transported in the custody of the chartering party at no additional charge.
- (b) Liability for loss or damage of baggage will be limited to fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each individual.

C. Objectionable Persons:

The carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or who shows conduct which is such, or is likely to be such, as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers. EXCEPTION: The above rules do not apply to persons who are ill and are accompanied by an attendant or nurse.

D. Animals or Birds:

Animals or birds will not be carried, except seeing-eye dogs accompanying their master.

E. Carrier's Liability:

- (a.) The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by Acts of God, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to a state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, snow storms, and other conditions beyond its control, and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any points at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agents or employees, but same is not guaranteed.
- (c) If an Act of God, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards and dangers of a state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, snow storms, and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate buses, either from the place of origin or any point en route, the carrier shall not be liable therefore, or be caused to be held liable for damages for any reason whatsoever.

F. Payment of Charges and Fees:

Payment of all charges and fees shall be the responsibility of the person or organization chartering the vehicle. The carrier reserves the right to collect such charges in advance unless prior credit arrangements have been made with the carrier.
