RULE

SECTION I
RULES AND REGULATIONS

5 APPLICATION OF TARIFF:

The Rules, Regulations, fares and charges, as set forth herein, apply in connection with the provisions of all charter services authorized to be provided by the carrier pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 789 issued in Case No. AP-2002-113, pursuant to WMATC Order No. 7139.

10 AVAILABILITY OF EQUIPMENT:

Charges named herein are based on vehicles being furnished of sufficient seating capacity to accommodate the chartering party; but carrier reserves the right, when operating conditions so require, to furnish vehicles of greater capacity, charges to be based on the capacity of vehicle ordered.

15 OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS:

The carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or who shows conduct which is such, or is likely to be such, as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers. EXCEPTION: The above rules do not apply to persons who are ill and are accompanied by an attendant or nurse.

20 BAGGAGE:

Baggage will not be checked.

(a) For charter trips, personal baggage, musical instruments, athletic equipment and other paraphernalia necessary for the purpose of the charter trip and limited to the capacity of the charter vehicle will be transported in the custody of the chartering party at no additional charge.

SECTION I
RULES AND REGULATIONS

55 DEPOSITS:

To reserve a coach, a deposit of \$100.00 per coach must be made with the charter order for each day the coach has been allocated. If after the equipment is allocated to the charter movement, the charter party cancels the trip, carrier may retain \$100.00 for each day it has forfeited business due to the coach having been guaranteed.

60 CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellations made more than 48 hours but less than 10 days prior to departure will be assessed a \$100.00 cancellation fee.

Cancellations made within 48 hours of departure will be assessed a \$200.00 cancellation fee.

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
