

On December 15, 1961, the Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., hereinafter called W. V. & M., filed with this Commission WMATC Tariff No. 7, to become effective January 15, 1962. Said Tariff No. 7 sets forth the Rules, Regulations and Passenger Fares, which fares show an increase over the fares now in effect.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That an investigation be made and hearing held concerning the propriety and reasonableness of said rates and charges;
- (2) A public hearing be held on this matter on January 8, 1962, at 10:00 A.M., 7 th Floor, Arlington County Court House, Court House Road, Arlington, Virginia;
- (3) Protests to said proposed increases shall be filed with the Commission, in writing, by January 5, 1962, at 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington 9, Virginia;
- (4) That W. V. & M. give notice of the filing of said Tariff, and of the time and place of hearing thereon, by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District at least twice, once each successive week, prior to said hearing date, and furnish the Commission with an affidavit to the effect that this requirement has been met.
