This Commission, by Order No. 4, authorized D. C. Transit System, Inc., temporary authority to operate the Wheaton Plaza Shoppers' Express in the manner set forth in said Order No. 4. This application relates to Route No. 1, Parkwood-Chevy Chase View, and requests that the Parkwood Loop operating over Franklin Street, Woodfield Road, Saul Road, Parkwood Drive, Wildwood Road, and Roxbury Drive, be eliminated and the services re-routed to operate from the intersection of University Boulevard West (Connecticut Avenue) and Knowles Avenue - west on Knowles Avenue, south on Summit Avenue, westerly on Cedar and Clearbrook Lanes, north on Clearbrook Place, west on Westbrook Lane, southerly on Parkwood Drive, east on Roxbury Drive, north on Wildwood Road, east on Everett Street, south on Thornwood Road and east on Saul Road to Connecticut Avenue and thence continue over regular route.

The requested change in routing will not change the frequency or scheduled number of trips operated and is intended to provide better coverage in the Parkwood-Chevy Chase View area. The Commission is of the opinion that a hearing on this matter is not necessary.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the temporary authority authorized in Order No. 4 be, and it hereby is, amended to authorized the re-routing hereinabove set forth.
