Application of D. C. Transit System, Inc.,)
to Re-Route the Glover Park-Trinidad Bus) Application No. 188
Line, Route D-3) WMATC File No. 29

An application has been filed by D. C. Transit System, Inc., to re-route the Glover Park-Trinidad Bus line, Route D-3, in order that said line may conform to changes in traffic regulations by the District of Columbia.

The proposed re-routing will eliminate the portion of the route traversing Virginia Avenue, N. W., a. m.-18th Street to Constitution Avenue, and establish the re-routed portion for a. m. eastbound trips from the intersection of Virginia Avenue and 18th Street, N. W., south on 18th Street, east on Constitution Avenue to its intersection with Virginia Avenue, thence continuing over Constitution Avenue and the existing route.

The requested re-routing will not change the frequency or scheduled number of trips operated over Route D-3 in the a. m. period. There will be no change of existing bus stops as a result of the proposed re-routing.

The Commission is of the opinion that the application should be approved, and that a hearing on this matter is not necessary.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is, hereby authorized to re-route the Glover Park-Trinidad Bus Line, Route D-3, as hereinabove described.

2. That this order become effective with the change of traffic regulations.
