On November 21, 1961, by Order No. 97, D. C. Transit System, Inc., was granted Temporary Authority to operate service between Silver Spring and the National Institutes of Health via Bethesda, Maryland, for a period of ninety (90) days, commencing December 18, 1961.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., has requested that the Temporary Authority be extended an additional thirty (30) days, and, good cause appearing, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Temporary Authority heretofore granted unto D. C. Transit System, Inc., Route N-7, be, and it is, hereby extended an additional thirty (30) days.
