D. C. Transit System, Inc., has filed an Application for temporary authority to operate the DOWNTOWN SHOPPER service in the business district of Washington, D. C. for a trial period of ninety (90) days to commence April 16, 1962.

The following is a detailed route description of the proposed service:

DOWNTOWN SHOPPER

From terminal stand on the north side of F Street, west of 14th Street; operate west on F Street to 15th Street, north on 15th Street to G Street, east on G Street to 14th Street, south on 14th Street to F Street, east on F Street to 7th Street, south on 7th Street to Market Space, west on Market Space to 8th Street, north on 8th Street to F Street, west on F Street to terminal stand west of 14th Street.

This service will be operated over the route described above with a 10¢ cash fare. Specially designed transfers will be issued upon payment of the fare which will permit travel between points on the route of this service, and may be used as often as desired, within a two hour period from time of issue. The proposed service will operate Monday thru Saturday in accordance with the schedule set forth in the Application.

No additional equipment will be required to provide this service as the buses specified in the Application are available for this operation. The Carrier is authorized to provide service in the general area to be served by the applicant and, therefor, the Commission feels that a Public Hearing on this matter is not necessary and will not be required.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That temporary authority be, and it is, hereby issued unto D. C. Transit System, Inc., for ninety (90) days, commencing April 16, 1962, to operate the DOWNTOWN SHOPPER over the route hereinabove described.
- (2) That the applicant submit to the Commission a statement of revenues and out-of-pocket expenses for each thirty (30) day period, said information to be received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days after each thirty (30) day period.
