The W M A Transit Company has filed an application for authority to establish new routes in Prince George's County and between points and places in Prince George's County and Washington, D. C. Change in route will be accomplished by rerouting the bus lines along streets already approved, with three exceptions:

(1) Service to Naval Research Laboratory, closed doors only over Atlantic Street, Nichols Avenue, Chesapeake Street and Overlook Avenue to Naval Research;

(2) Marlow Heights Express Route with closed doors over Branch Avenue between Southern Avenue, S.E., and Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E.;

(3) Express route via East Capitol Street, with certain restrictions as to bus stops.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., is the only other regular route carrier operating in the general area affected by this request, and has indicated that it has no objections to the proposed rerouting.

In order that the over-all route revision proposed by the applicant may go into effect promptly on April 2, 1962, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that it should grant the applicant temporary authority to operate over the above mentioned routes, pending formal hearing on this application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that W M A Transit Company be, and it is, hereby granted temporary authority to operate over the routes hereinabove described for a period of ninety (90) days, pending formal hearing on its application.
