Clancy Limousine Service, Inc., has heretofore filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity under Section 4(a), Article XII, of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact (grandfather clause).

A joint application has been filed by Clancy Limousine Service, Inc. (hereinafter called Clancy) and Mayflower Hotel Garage, Inc. (hereinafter called Mayflower), seeking the approval of the Commission to the sale by Clancy to Mayflower of property and such operating rights, as Clancy was bona fide entitled to on March 22, 1961, and to the substitution of Mayflower as applicant in Application No. 41.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is, hereby set for hearing on Monday, May 7, 1962, at 9:30 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 2201 North Moore Street, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That the applicants publish notice of this hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District once at least ten (10) days prior to said May 7, 1962.
3. Any person desiring to protest this application shall do so, in writing, at least three (3) days prior to said May 7, 1962.
