Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., has filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to extend its existing regular route common carrier of passenger service over the Capital Beltway (Interstate Highway #495).

The following is a detailed route description:

1. Between Junction Virginia State Highway #236 and Interstate Highway #495; over Interstate Highway #495 to its Junction with Maryland State Highway #190 (River Road), including all interchange points and access and interchange routes. Serving All Intermediate Points.

2. Between Junction George Washington Memorial Parkway and access road to Central Intelligence Agency; over George Washington Memorial Parkway to its Junction with Interstate Highway #495, including all interchange points and access and interchange routes. Serving All Intermediate Points.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is, hereby set for hearing on June 4, 1962, at 9:30 a.m., at the office of the Commission, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington, Virginia.

2. That the applicant publish notice of this hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District at least twenty (20) days prior to said June 4, 1962.

3. Any person desiring to protest this application shall do so, in writing, at least five (5) days prior to said June 4, 1962.
