for fare increases.)

On April 29, 1961, Airport Transport, Inc., and Airport Transport, Inc. of Virginia, filed a joint application for fare increases, as set forth in its WMATC Tariff No. 2, which also cancels WMATC Tariff No. 1, effective June 1, 1961, said increases being generally twenty percent (20%) above the fares presently in effect.

The Commission, after giving due consideration to the financial condition of the applicants, their revenue requirements, and their operations as to economy and efficiency, is of the opinion that said WMATC tariff No. 2 should be suspended, pending further investigation and hearing, in order to determine the reasonableness of said fares.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

(1). That said WMATC Tariff No. 2 be, and it is, hereby suspended and the use of the fares stated therein deferred until August 28, 1961, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, to enable the Commission to examine and investigate the supporting data filed with said tariff, and to provide time for the Commission's Accounting Department to make an audit and report covering the matters involved herein.

(2). That the matters involved in this proceeding be set for hearing to be held in the Commission's offices at 1801 N. Moore St. Rosslyn, Virginia, on the 28th day of June, 1961, at 9:30 a. m. Eastern Daylight Saving Time, at which time the applicants shall appear and offer evidence in support of the fares shown on said tariff and anyone may appear and make such objection thereto as may be deemed proper.

(3). That the applicants give notice of the filing of said Tariff, and of the time and place of hearing thereon, by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District at least twice, once each successive week, prior to said hearing date.
