The Commission is in receipt of numerous requests to require D. C. Transit System, Inc., to re-route the Glover Park-Trinidad Bus Lines, Routes D-1 and D-2 as follows:

(a) Re-route Portion

Outbound - No change in route or terminal stand.

Inbound - From present terminal east side of 41st Street south of Davis Place N. W., continue north on 41st Street to Edmunds Street, east on Edmunds Street to 39th Street, south on 39th Street, over Davis Place, and thence on the existing route.

(b) Eliminate Portion

Davis Place between 41st Street and 39th Street.

The Commission is of the opinion that it should institute an investigation to determine whether the existing services should be modified, or additional services over additional routes provided as the public convenience and necessity may require, as may pertain to Routes D-1 and D-2.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That an investigation be made and hearing held to determine whether or not the proposed re-routing should be required.
2. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is, hereby made a respondent to the proceeding.

3. That the hearing on this matter be held on June 25, 1962, at 9:30 A.M., E.D.S.T., in the office of the Commission, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington, Virginia.

4. That notice of this hearing be given to all known interested persons, and be published in a newspaper of general circulation of the Metropolitan District once, at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.

5. Any interested person desiring to participate in this matter should be present at said hearing for the purpose of giving testimony.
