Pursuant to Section 4(a), Article XII, Title II, Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, White House Sightseeing Corporation, Washington, D. C., seasonably filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, said certificate to authorize such transportation as it was bona fide performing on March 22, 1961, the effective date of the Compact.

It appears that the White House Sightseeing Corporation was bona fide engaged in, and is entitled to a certificate to authorize, the transportation set forth below. In all other respects the application should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1 be, and it is, hereby granted to White House Sightseeing Corporation to transport passengers for hire as follows:

IRREGULAR ROUTE SPECIAL OR CHARTER OPERATIONS:

Passengers, and their baggage, in special or charter operations consisting of round trip sightseeing or pleasure tours, beginning and ending at points within the Metropolitan District, restricted, however, from performing transportation intrastate within the States of Maryland and Virginia.

(2) That in all other respects, the application be, and it is hereby, denied.
