The Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company, hereinafter referred to as A. B. & W. Transit Co., filed a complaint against the Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., hereinafter referred to as W. V. & M. Coach Co., alleging that W. V. & M. Coach Co. submitted a bid to the Contracting Officer, Headquarters, Military District of Washington, United States Army, Gravelly Point, Washington, D. C., with charges different from those on file with the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission.

W. V. & M. has filed an answer to this complaint, alleging that they do hold the necessary authority from this Commission to render the service and that W. V. & M. is in compliance with Regulation 59 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The answer being a denial to the complaint, the Commission is of the opinion that this matter should be set for hearing.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
