

Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., on June 18, 1962, filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to serve all intermediate points on routes between Fairfax, Virginia, and Dulles International Airport, all of the access roads to which (Dulles) are situated and located in Fairfax County in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
