By Order No. 153, Docket No. 19, served June 8, 1962, the Commission ordered that an investigation be made and a hearing held to determine whether D. C. Transit System, Inc., should re-route its Glover Park-Trinidad bus lines Routes D-1 and D-2 as follows:

(a) Re-route Portion

Outbound - No change in route or terminal stand.

Inbound - From present terminal east side of 41st Street south of Davis Place, N. W., continue north on 41st Street to Edmunds Street, east on Edmunds Street to 39th Street, south on 39th Street, over Davis Place, and thence on the existing route.

(b) Eliminate Portion

Davis Place between 41st Street and 39th Street.

After due notice, given pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations, a public hearing was held before Mr. Charles W. Overhouse, hearing Examiner, in the Commission's office, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington 9, Virginia, on June 25, 1962. Certificate of Notice has been made a part of the record.

Testimony by all public witnesses indicated that public convenience and necessity require that D. C. Transit System, Inc., re-route in accordance with the route described in the following order.

A public hearing having been held in the above-entitled matter, the matter having been submitted, the Commission being fully advised therein,

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

(1) That D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, ordered to re-route the Glover Park-Trinidad bus lines, Routes D-1 and D-2 in the following manner:

Inbound - From present terminal east side of 41st Street south of Davis Place, N. W., continue north on 41st Street to Edmunds Street, east on Edmunds Street to 39th Street, south on 39th Street, over Davis Place, and thence on the existing route.

(2) That this Order become effective immediately upon the completion of the District of Columbia Department of Highways and Traffic putting into effect "No Parking At Any Time" regulations on the north side of Edmunds Street, N. W., between 41st and 39th Streets, and making 39th Street, N. W., between Edmunds Street and Davis Place, N. W., one-way southbound.
