An application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity was filed by Samuel Daumit under Section 4(a), Article XII, of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact.

The facts as disclosed by the application reveal that the applicant was not bona fide performing any transportation subject to the Compact at the inception date (March 22, 1961) in that he neither owned nor leased a motor vehicle to perform any service. The applicant did not hold a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Interstate Commerce Commission for the interstate aspect of the operation.

Based on the foregoing facts, the Commission finds that this application should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application be, and it is, hereby denied.
