W M A Transit Company and D. C. Transit System, Inc., have filed formal complaints against Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, alleging that Randolph P. Owens, t/a O and K Bus Service, has been, and is, illegally engaged in charter operations and other transportation for hire within the Metropolitan District. The complaints also seek the Commission to issue an order requiring Randolph P. Owens, t/a O and K Bus Service, to cease and desist from said operations and grant such other relief as may be just and reasonable within the purpose and intent of the Compact.

Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, has not filed an answer to either complaint. The parties having failed to settle the disputes, the issues are joined and the Commission is of the opinion that these matters should be set for hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That the formal complaints filed by W M A Transit Company and D. C. Transit System, Inc., against Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, be, and they are, hereby consolidated for purpose of hearing and decision.

2. That the complaints be, and they are, hereby set for hearing on September 12, 1962, at 10 a.m., D.S.T., in the office of the

Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington, Virginia.

3. That Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, be, and he is, hereby made respondent to this proceeding.
