This was an application by Clancy Limousine Service, Inc. (hereinafter called Clancy) and the Mayflower Hotel Garage, Inc. (hereinafter called Mayflower), seeking the approval of the Commission to the sale by Clancy to Mayflower of certain property and such operating rights as Clancy was bona fide entitled to on March 22, 1961, and to the substitution of Mayflower as applicant in Application No. 41.

The Commission today, in Order No. 189, has dismissed the application of Clancy for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. Therefore, the Commission is of the opinion that it does not have jurisdiction to consider the matters contained herein, and that this application should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Clancy Limousine Service, Inc., and Mayflower Hotel Garage, Inc., for purchase of property and operating rights and to the substitution of the Mayflower Hotel Garage, Inc., as applicant in Application No. 41 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
