On June 8, 1961 by Order No. 17, this Commission suspended for ninety (90) days Tariff MP-ICC No. 36, filed the the Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc. In said order, the Commission ordered an investigation be made and hearing held concerning the propriety and reasonableness of the proposed rates and charges as set forth in said Tariff No. 36. In view of the fact that the Commission is not in a position to issue an order in this proceeding, it is of the opinion that the suspension period should be extended and a date should be set for hearing.

On June 15, 1961, a pre-hearing conference was conducted by the Commission. The hearing dates hereinafter set forth were mutually agreed upon by all parties at the meeting and confirmed by the Commission at its meeting on June 16, 1961. The following attended the pre-hearing conference:


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
