The Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc. has filed an application for reconsideration of Order No. 186, issued August 16, 1962, which granted the application of D. C. Transit for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to transport passengers between Montgomery County, Maryland, and the CIA Building, Virginia.

The Commission is of the opinion that it should reconsider said Order and that a further hearing in this matter is necessary.
