Airport Transport, Inc. has heretofore filed applications for authority to authorize the transportation of passengers for hire in interstate commerce, (1) between the Dulles International Airport on one hand, and, on the other hand, points and places in Montgomery County, (2) between Washington National Airport and the Dulles International Airport via the District of Columbia, restricted to the transportation of passengers having a prior or subsequent movement by air, and (3) between Washington, D. C. and the Dulles International Airport.

Pending a final disposition of these applications, Airport Transport, Inc. has requested temporary authority to perform the transportation set forth above.

The Commission is of the opinion that there is an immediate and urgent need for such transportation, that there is no common carrier service capable of meeting the need, and that temporary authority should be authorized for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days or final determination of the matters set forth in the applications, whichever occurs earliest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Airport Transport, Inc. be, and it is hereby, granted temporary authority to perform the transportation set forth for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days or final determination of the applications seeking such authority, whichever occurs earliest.
