The Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., has filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize it to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle passengers and their baggage, and express and newspapers in the same vehicle with passengers, between the Junction of Virginia Highway No. 693 (Westmoreland Street) and Virginia Highway No. 695 (Kirby Road), over Virginia Highway No. 693, to its junction with Virginia Highway No. 123, and return over the same route, serving all intermediate points, in Fairfax County, Virginia.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on February 20, 1963, at 10:00 a.m. at the office of the Commission, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That the applicant publish notice of this application and hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District at least fifteen (15) days prior to said February 20, 1963.
3. Any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing at least ten (10) days prior to said February 20, 1963.
