WMA Transit Company has filed a complaint against Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, alleging that Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, has been, and is, illegally engaged in charter operations and other transportation for hire within the Metropolitan District. The complaint also seeks the Commission to take such action as it may deem necessary for violation of the Act, and to prevent future violations of the Act by Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service.

Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, filed an answer alleging the complaint fails to set forth definite information.

The parties having failed to settle the dispute informally, the Commission is of the opinion that this matter should be set for hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the formal complaint filed by WMA Transit Company against Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on May 20, 1963, at 10:00 A.M., in the offices of the Commission, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington 9, Virginia.
2. That Randolph P. Owens, Jr., t/a O and K Bus Service, be, and he is hereby, made respondent to this proceeding.
3. That a copy of this Order be posted in the office of the Executive Director not less than fifteen (15) days in advance of the date set herein for hearing.
