
An application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity was filed by Paul A. Swan, t/a Federal Tours, pursuant to Section 4(a), Article XII of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact. The application seeks "grandfather" authority for such transportation as he was bona fide engaged in on March 22, 1961, the effective date of the Compact.

The Commission has held informal conferences with the applicant and interested parties. Another informal conference had been set for May 8, 1963. Prior to this date, however, applicant advised the Commission that he did not wish to pursue the application and requested that his application be dismissed.

The Commission is of the opinion that the application should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Paul A. Swan, t/a Federal Tours, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
