The Georgia Avenue-Seventh Street Bus Line has recently been detoured from its regular route along Seventh Street, S.W., over a temporary route via D Street, S.W., Sixth Street, S.W., and G Street, S.W., to be used for an indefinite period.

Request has been made for the establishment of a stop at Sixth and E Streets, S.W., in lieu of the former regular route stop at Seventh and E Streets, S.W. It appears that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of a bus stop at Sixth and E Streets, S.W. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that a bus stop be established at the following location:

On Sixth Street, S.W.

East Side, south of E Street
West Side, north of E Street

That the following bus stop be abolished:

On Seventh Street, S.W.

East side, south of E Street
West side, north of E Street

That this Order become effective immediately.
