Landers Tram Service, Inc., Washington, D. C., has filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize it to operate as a carrier by motor vehicle over regular routes as follows:

From the Washington Monument at 15th Street; over 15th Street to Jefferson Drive; thence over Jefferson Drive to 12th Street; thence over 12th Street to Maine Avenue; thence over Maine Avenue to 15th Street; thence over 15th Street to Jefferson Drive; thence over Jefferson Drive to 14th Street; thence over 14th Street to Independence Avenue; thence over Independence Avenue to 15th Street; thence over 15th Street to Thomas Jefferson Memorial Road; thence over Thomas Jefferson Memorial Road to Ohio Drive; thence over Ohio Drive to Lincoln Memorial Circle; thence over Lincoln Memorial Circle to Henry Bacon Drive; thence over Henry Bacon Drive to Constitution Avenue; thence over Constitution Avenue to 19th Street; thence over 19th Street to C Street; thence over C Street to 18th Street; thence over 18th Street to Pennsylvania Avenue; thence over Pennsylvania Avenue to East Executive Avenue; thence over East Executive Avenue to 15th Street; thence over 15th Street to Constitution Avenue; thence over Constitution Avenue to 4th Street; thence over 4th Street to Madison Drive; thence over Madison Drive to 15th Street; thence over 15th Street to the Washington Monument.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


