W M A Transit Company has filed an application for authority to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle over regular routes to serve between Washington, D. C. and Greenbelt, Maryland (Route R). The applicant proposes to conduct a scheduled operation with sixteen (16) trips on weekdays to and from Washington, D. C. The route description and time schedule is more fully set forth in the application on file with the Commission.

The tariff proposed by the applicant calls for a cash fare ranging from 45¢ to 60¢. The applicant proposes to serve this route with three (3) buses during rush hours, and one bus during non-rush hours.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


