W M A Transit Company has filed new tariffs and supplements, with supporting application, proposing increases in fares, to become effective July 1, 1963.

Notice of the above has been published in newspapers of general circulation in the Metropolitan District.

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariffs and supplements be suspended, and the use of the fares stated therein deferred, in order that an investigation may be held and hearing conducted to determine the propriety and reasonableness of said proposed fares.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That WMATC Tariff No. 11 and Supplement No. 1 to WMATC Tariff No. 11, and Supplement No. 1 to WMATC Tariff No. 1, be, and they are hereby, suspended, and the use of the fares stated therein deferred, until September 23, 1963, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
2. That an investigation of the proposed fares be conducted by the staff of the Commission.
