
Dawson Charter Service, Inc., has filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle over irregular routes, transporting passengers and their baggage in round-trip, special, and charter party service, from points in Montgomery County, Maryland, to points in the District of Columbia, and that portion of Virginia within the Washington Metropolitan Transit District.

The Interstate Commerce Commission has ordered a similar application, by the applicant, to be heard at its office. The applicant has requested, and the Commission concurs, that a joint hearing will be advantageous in this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on July 30, 1963, at 9:30 A.M., in the office of the Interstate Commerce Commission, Washington, D. C.
2. That the applicant publish notice of this application and hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District at least twenty (20) days prior to July 30, 1963.
3. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing, addressed to this Commission, at least five (5) days prior to said hearing date of July 30, 1963.
