The Commission has heretofore (Order No. 245, issued April 12, 1963) discussed problems of depreciation of non-bus property of D. C. Transit System, Inc., and indicated that it would consider ordering a depreciation reserve study. The Commission is now of the opinion that it should initiate a depreciation reserve study of all non-bus property of D. C. Transit System, Inc.

The costs of the study will be assessed against the carrier and payments will be due on ten days notice. The Commission has selected Stone and Webster Service Corporation to conduct the depreciation study, which will begin on or after August 1, 1963.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a depreciation study of all non-bus property of D. C. Transit System, Inc. be conducted.
2. That Stone and Webster Service Corporation be employed to conduct the depreciation study ordered herein.
3. That D. C. Transit System, Inc. be, and it is hereby, assessed the cost of such study, to be paid in such sum or sums as hereafter determined by the Executive Director.
