

Applications for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity by the A. B. & W. Transit Company, D. C. Transit System, Inc., W M A Transit Company, and W. V. & M. Coach Company. ) Applications Nos. 23, 43, 60, and 64

Pursuant to Section 4(a), Article XII of the Compact, A. B. & W. Transit Company (Application No. 43), D. C. Transit System, Inc. (Application No. 64), W M A Transit Company (Application No. 23), and the W. V. & M. Coach Company, Inc. (Application No. 60), have heretofore seasonably filed "grandfather" applications for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity. The Commission is of the opinion that these applications should be assigned to an examiner for review, informal conferences (where necessary), and issuance of proposed certificates. Upon the issuance of a proposed certificate, all parties of record to the applications may file exceptions thereto in accordance with our rules and regulations.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the above applications be, and they hereby are, assigned to examiner Russell W. Cunningham for further processing in accordance with the administrative mandate hereinabove set forth.
