Montgomery Charter Service, Inc. has filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to authorize the transportation by motor vehicle of passengers and their baggage from points in Montgomery County, Maryland to the Washington National Airport on a regular schedule. The applicant proposes to use a Cadillac limousine and Chevrolet Station Wagons, each having a seating capacity of eight (8) passengers, in addition to the driver, to render this proposed service.

The applicant proposes to operate from Rockville via Bethesda, Maryland, to the Washington National Airport and from Wheaton via Silver Springs, Maryland, to the Washington National Airport, hourly, between the hours of 6:00 A. M. and 7:00 P. M., seven days a week. The proposed time schedules, points of origin, and proposed tariffs are more fully set forth in the application on file with the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


