An application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity was filed by Erman F. Frazier, t/a Star Line Sightseeing Tours, pursuant to Section 4(a), Article XII, of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact. The application seeks "grandfather" authority for such transportation as he was bona fide engaged in on March 22, 1961, the effective date of the Compact.

The applicant has refused to accept registered mail from the Commission and has failed to answer other correspondence, except to advise the Chief Clerk by telephone that he does not wish to pursue his application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Erman F. Frazier, t/a Star Line Sightseeing Tours for a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
