By Order No. 347, issued March 17, 1964, the Commission published proposed regulations which would define the terms "charter" and "special operations" and redefine the term "regular route", as more particularly set forth in said Order. The Order also required comments on the proposals to be submitted in writing on or before March 30, 1964. Copies of the Order were sent to all known interested persons.

Comments were received from D. C. Transit System, Inc., the W. V. & M. Coach Company, Inc., and the Director of the Bureau of National Capital Airports, Federal Aviation Agency, suggesting minor changes in language.

The Commission finds that the proposed redefinition of Regulation 51-06 should be amended by striking the last sentence, changing the period preceding it to a comma, and adding the words, "including passengers in charter and special operations".

The Commission finds that proposed Regulation 51-13 should be amended by adding the phrase, "or vehicles", immediately following the term "vehicle".

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed Regulations, as amended, should be adopted.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Regulation 51-06 be, and it is hereby, amended as follows:

51-06. Regular Route Operation: The term "regular route operation" means scheduled service over designated streets and highways between fixed termini for the purpose of performing mass transportation of passengers; provided, that the holder of regular route authority may conduct any type of operations between points on and over said route, including passengers in charter and special operations.


2. That the following Regulations be, and they are hereby, promulgated and adopted:

51-13. Charter Operation: The term "charter operation" means the transportation of a group of passengers who, pursuant to a common purpose and under a single contract, has acquired the exclusive use of a vehicle or vehicles to travel together.

51-14. Special Operation: The term "special operation" means the transportation of passengers for a special trip, for which the carrier contracts with each individual separately.

3. That this Order become effective June 12, 1964.
