On June 12, 1964, D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed Supplement No. 3 to WMATC Tariff No. 10, to become effective July 12, 1964. The purpose of the supplement is to grant a lower rate of charges for certain sightseeing trips on a per capita basis.

The Gray Line, Incorporated, has filed with the Commission a complaint seeking suspension and formal investigation of Supplement No. 3 to WMATC Tariff No. 10 issued by D. C. Transit System, Inc.


The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed supplement should be suspended and the use of the fares stated therein deferred in order that an investigation may be held to determine the propriety and reasonableness of said proposed fares.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Supplement No. 3 of WMATC Tariff No. 10 be, and it is hereby, suspended, and the use of the fares stated therein deferred until October 10, 1964, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission;
2. That an investigation be made and hearing held concerning the propriety and reasonableness of the proposed fares and regulations.

3. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on August 5, 1964, at 10:00 A. M., in the office of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
