The Commission is responsible for making a certification to the Board of Commissioners of the District of Columbia, relating to school fare subsidies. It appears that the D. C. Transit System, Inc., and the W M A Transit Company are the only carriers eligible to participate in this program. The Commission, by Order No. 199, served September 17, 1962, determined that it was necessary for its staff to make a special evaluation of the accounts of said carriers before making said certification, and that such account evaluation would entail expenses subject to Section 19(a), Article XII, Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact. The Commission assessed subject companies \$5,400.00 to cover the expenses of said evaluation to be incurred in the period October 1, 1962, to June 30, 1963.

By Order No. 282, served July 3, 1963, the companies were assessed \$9,500.00 to cover the cost of the special evaluation of accounts for the period July 1, 1963, through June 30, 1964. Of this amount, there is a balance of \$538.59 remaining as of June 30, 1964.

It is the opinion of the Commission that an additional assessment of \$10,000.00 is a reasonable amount to cover the cost of said evaluation estimated to be incurred in the period July 1, 1964, through June 30, 1965.

Further, it is the opinion of the Commission, determined by past experience, that eighty-five percent (85%) of the cost should be borne by D. C. Transit System, Inc., and fifteen percent (15%) by W M A Transit Company.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby,


directed to deposit \$8,500.00 in the name and to the credit of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission, Account 0 94 59 499, in the Old Dominion Bank, 2057 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia, one-half of this sum on or before July 28, 1964, and one-half on or before January 6, 1965.

2. That W M A Transit Company be, and it is hereby, directed to deposit \$1,500.00 in the name and to the credit of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission, Account 0 94 59 499, in the Old Dominion Bank, 2057 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia, one-half of this sum on or before July 28, 1964, and one-half on or before January 6, 1965.

3. That the Commission's financial records be made to reflect said deposits and all sums disbursed by the Commission in defraying the expenses of this proceeding.

4. That the sums hereby assessed may be charged to operating expenses and the carriers may amortize such amounts over the period of July 1, 1964, through June 30, 1965.
