Whereas, W. V. & M. has heretofore filed an application for fare increases, in the form of MP-I.C.C. Tariff No. 36; and,

Whereas, by Orders Nos. 17 and 28 the Commission has suspended and set for hearing said Tariff No. 36; and,

Whereas, W. V. & M. filed a petition, on June 13, 1961, to file a supplement to said Tariff and to vacate the suspension of the involved fares; and,

Whereas, by letter dated July 10, 1961, W. V. & M., by its Counsel, S. H. Kahn, requested special permission to cancel, on one day's notice, by supplement, Tariff No. 36; special permission having been granted; and the appropriate supplement, No. 2 to MP-I.C.C. No. 36, having been filed;

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That said application for increased fares be, and it is, hereby dismissed without prejudice.

(2) That said petition to file supplement and vacate suspension be, and it is, hereby denied.

(3) That the hearing scheduled on August 7, 8, 14 and 15 be, and it is, hereby cancelled.
