On September 22, 1964, A. B. & W. Transit Company, Inc., filed an application with the Commission to change its National Airport Line, Route No. 11, so as to operate southbound over Cavalier Drive and Belleview Boulevard between the intersections of Cavalier Drive and Cornell Drive and Belleview Boulevard and Cornell Drive, in lieu of its present southbound operation over Cornell Drive between said intersections, to be effective October 8, 1964.

The following is a detailed description of the change:

PRESENT ROUTE: To Bucknell Manor; via regular route to Cavalier Drive; left on Cavalier Drive to Cornell Drive; left on Cornell Drive to Belleview Boulevard; left on Belleview Boulevard to Swarthmore Drive; right on Swarthmore Drive and regular route.

PROPOSED ROUTE: To Bucknell Manor; via regular route to Cavalier Drive; left on Cavalier Drive to Belleview Boulevard; left on Belleview Boulevard to Swarthmore Drive; right on Swarthmore Drive and regular route.

The proposed re-routing will not change the schedule or fare, nor will it affect any other carriers. In its application A. B. & W. Transit Company states its reason for requesting the change is to eliminate a very dangerous turn at the intersection of Belleview Boulevard (Beacon Hill Road) and Cornell Drive. The change would provide the operators with an additional block to observe traffic before making the left turn.

The Commission is of the opinion that there is an urgent need for the change of route requested, and, pending hearing on said application, temporary authority should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That temporary authority be granted to A. B. & W. Transit Company, effective October 8, 1964, to re-route the National Airport Line, Route 11, as described in the Proposed Route, as set forth above, for a period of ninety (90) days, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
2. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing at 9:30 A.M., Wednesday, November 4, 1964, in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
3. That A. B. & W. Transit Company post notice of the subject matter of this hearing, and of the time and place thereof, at each of the three (3) affected bus stops along Cornell Drive.
4. That notice of the application be given in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, in writing, at least once, thirty (30) days prior to said November 4, 1964.
5. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing, at least five (5) days prior to said November 4, 1964.
