On June 4, 1964, by virtue of Route Authorization No. 1-64, this Commission granted temporary authority effective June 15, 1964, to A. B. & W. Transit Company to extend the Columbia Pike Line, Route 16, in the following manner:

To the Pentagon and Washington:

From the intersection of Virginia Route 236 and Ravensworth Road, south on Ravensworth Road to Elgar Street, left on Elgar Street to Heming Avenue, right on Heming Avenue to Leesville Boulevard, left on Leesville Boulevard to Back Lick Road, left on Back Lick Road to Columbia Pike, right on Columbia Pike then via regular route.

From Washington and the Pentagon:

Existing route to the intersection of Virginia Route 236 and Ravensworth Road, south on Ravensworth Road to Elgar Street, left on Elgar Street to Heming Avenue, right on Heming Avenue to Leesville Boulevard, left on Leesville Boulevard to Back Lick Road, left on Back Lick Road to Virginia Route 236 (end of line).

A. B. & W. Transit Company has filed application for permanent authority to continue the Route 16 service now being performed, on a temporary basis, as authorized by the Commission.

The applicant requests this authority without any change in route, fares or schedule.

The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is required on this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on Wednesday, November 4, 1964, at 9:30 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That the applicant publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said November 4, 1964.
3. Any person desiring to protest this application shall do so, in writing, at least ten (10) days prior to said November 4, 1964.
