The Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., has filed an application (No. 284) for authority to extend its Route 3-S between the junctions of Virginia Highway 7 -- Dulles Airport Access Highway and Virginia Highway 28 -- Dulles Airport Access Highway via Virginia Highway 7, Virginia Highway 606, and Virginia Highway 28, in the rendition of regular route, common carriage.

By Application No. 285, the applicant seeks temporary authority to render the service over the above described route pending determination of said Application No. 284, on the basis that there is an immediate and urgent need for the proposed service. Notice of the application for temporary authority (No. 285) was served on all authorized carriers. The Commission did not receive any objections to the request for temporary authority.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that there is an immediate and urgent need for the proposed service, which proposed route has no carrier service capable of meeting such need, and that temporary authority should be issued.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., be, and it is hereby, issued temporary authority to extend its Route 3-S between the junctions of Virginia Highway 7 -- Dulles Airport Access Highway and Virginia Highway 28 -- Dulles Airport Access Highway via

Virginia Highway 7, Virginia Highway 606, and Virginia Highway 28, in the rendition of regular route, common carriage for a period of One Hundred Eighty (180) days.

2. The matters in Application No. 284 be, and they are hereby, set for hearing on Monday, November 16, 1964, at 10:00 A.M. in the office of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.

3. Any person desiring to protest said Application No. 284 shall do so, in writing, at least ten (10) days prior to said November 16, 1964.
