On January 26, 1965, Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., (W. V. & M.) filed an application with the Commission to change its Lines 10, 11 and 8-N, so as to operate over South Kenmore Street in lieu of Shirlington Road. The following is a detailed description of the change.

NORTHBOUND:

Via regular route to Shirlington Road, thence over Shirlington Road to South Kenmore Street, left on South Kenmore Street to South Walter Reed Drive, right on South Walter Reed Drive and regular route.

SOUTHBOUND:

Via regular route to South Walter Reed Drive, thence over South Walter Reed Drive to South Kenmore Street, left on South Kenmore Street to Shirlington Road, right on Shirlington Road and regular route.

The proposed rerouting will not change the schedule or fare. In its application, W. V. & M. states that its reason for requesting the change is to utilize the improved four-lane South Kenmore Street in lieu of using the two-lane Shirlington Road and

for operating convenience to eliminate a dangerous left turn from Shirlington Road into South Glebe Road.

Line 10 is operated by W. V. & M. and the Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company (A. B. & W.), jointly, and the Commission has received application from A. B. & W. to make the same changes as set forth herein.

The attorney of record in this proceeding is Manuel J. Davis of Davis, Smith & Toomey, 1629 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

The Commission is of the opinion that a hearing on this matter is required.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on Monday, March 8, 1965, at 10:30 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That the applicant publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said March 8, 1965.
3. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing, with a copy to the attorney of record, at least ten (10) days prior to said March 8, 1965.
